- Purchase medical supplies for La Madonne Orphanage in Haiti.

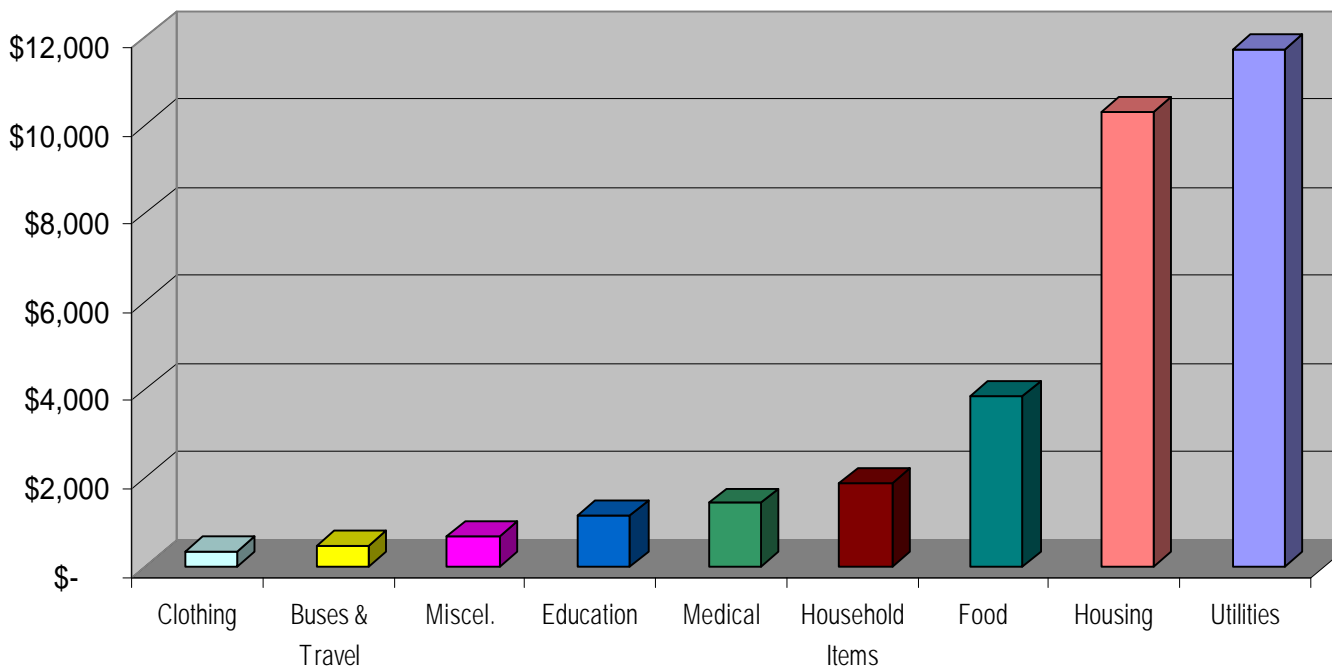
